





New Vocabulary

 germination	When the seed soaks up water and swells, and the tiny new plant bursts out of the shell.
 shoot	A shoot grows upwards from the seed or plant to find sunlight.
 sunlight	Plants need light from the sun to grow well.
 seedling	A young plant grown from a seed.
 bulb	The name given to an underground bud.
 seed	A seed has a new beginning of a plant along with a store of food to help to grow.
 grow	When a plant gets bigger over time.



Seeds and bulbs


Plants can grow from either a bulb or a seed.

What plants need to survive


Plants need water, sunlight and a suitable temperature to grow.

 Mary was a botanist who studied plants.





Features that occur naturally.





This is a map of the UK. The UK is made up of 4 countries.





The UK is surrounded by 3 seas.
